# **TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN**

## OVERVIEW

We seek to ensure that students, staff and members of our wider community are safe. Additionally, it is our goal to ensure that our community is impacted as minimally as possible by school traffic. Our Traffic Management Plan has been devised in consultation with Brisbane City Council.

Parents are expected to comply with this plan and to fully cooperate with the directives of staff. Please let grandparents and other carers know this information if they are going to drop off or pick up your children from school

We ask our neighbours and other members of the local community to please immediately inform us of any problems or concerns.

## DO

- Stick to the 40km/h speed limit in the school zone.
- Consider arriving closer to 2:45 pm pick up.
- Use Ferndale Street as the collection point for older years.
- Remain in your vehicle at all times when using the Ferndale St pick up zone.
- Use Ipswich Rd Car Park as collection point for younger years.
- Ensure students enter the car through the kerbside door.
- When you reach the pickup zone, drive to the front of the queue so that as many cars as possible can pull in behind you.
- Ensure your child's seat belt is securely fastened before pulling away from the kerb.
- Use the designated crossing area if walking across the road.
- Please let grandparents and other carers know this information if they are going to collect your children from school.
- Please consider neighbours.

## DON'T

- For their safety, students should only get into and out of the car directly onto the kerb.
- Do not jump the queue of waiting for traffic.
- Do not allow students to get out of the car on the traffic side.
- Do not do a U-turn or 3 point turn anywhere in the vicinity of the school.
- You don't need to get out of the car as supervising teachers will assist your children to get into the car.
- Do not double park.
- Do not pull into the school driveway to drop off or collect children.
- Do not park or stop across driveways.

## Mary Immaculate Primary School Traffic and Road Safety Map

All roads surrounding and adjoining Mary Immaculate Primary are signed and subject to School Zone Road Restrictions from 7:00am to 9:00am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm on all school days.



- No Standing zone
- Loading Zone 7:00-9:00 am and 2:00-4:00 pm school days

Please be patient. Your patience and cooperation is essential as we work together to make both our school drop off and pick up zones and the surrounding streets safe for children, neighbours and the community.



## 1. Ipswich Rd Carpark

This area is used for staff parking and temporary visitor parking. Parent pick up and drop off for lower year students between 8:15-8:40 am and 2:45-3:15 pm.



## 2. School Drop Off/ Pick Up Zone

Loading zone 8:00 am – 8:45am and 2:30- 3:30 pm school days. Please enter via Ipswich Rd. Do not perform U-turn or 3 point turns on Ferndale St.

The School Drop Off/Pick Up Zone is a designated No Parking Zone and is to be used for a maximum of 2 minutes to drop off or pick up passengers. Please stay in your car at all times and never leave your car unattended. This zone is designed for quick entry and exit to minimise congestion and confusion.



## 3. Pedestrian Crossing

There is a designated pedestrian crossing on Ferndale St with a crossing supervisor. Please use this point if you are parking on the far side of Ferndale St and crossing the road on foot.

The crossing is sign posted, when you are approaching the crossing you must look out for children/pedestrians. Always slow down near school crossings and give way to pedestrians. The area either side of the crossing is a No Standing Zone, never stop in this area as it blocks visibility of the crossing.



## 4. Entry/ Exit Points

Pedestrians are to enter and exit the school through designated entry and exit gates. Pedestrians are not to use School driveways as access points.



## 5. Disabled Parking

The disabled parking zone should only be accessed by vehicles displaying disabled parking permits.
