Tuckshop is open on Friday's, relying solely on parent volunteers to operate.

Friday Tuckshop is lunch food (hot food and sandwiches), over-the-counter snacks and drinks. This requires a minimum of two volunteers to arrive at 8.40am and finish at midday.

**Tuckshop days can change each year depending on how many volunteers are available on any given day. We open any day we have enough volunteers to operate.**
